No Exceptions.***

Fantasy Makeup Theme: “Wizard of Oz Theme”

4 facial stations will be set up

Additional stations with chairs for makeup and fantasy makeup applications

If more than 4 competitors at a time, we will rotate them with one group starting with the facial and the other group starting with the beauty makeup application.

We will follow the SkillsUSA 2013-2014 national technical standards guidelines and scoring system.

Equipment and Materials supplied by the technical committee include:

- o Facial tables
- o Chairs
- o Table for products
- o All products for the facial and massage application**
- o Hot and Cold Water
- o Set of sheets for each contestant
- o Blanket for the tables

**Contestant will need to bring 2 facial brushes for use with the product.

A Step by Step procedure sheet and product information will be sent out prior to the contest date.

Time will be given for a break; pop machine is available, fast food is within walking distance or snacks may be brought in.

PARKING:

PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE SALON PARKING LOT. PARKING IS AVAILABLE ON SNELLING AVENUE AND SCHEFFER AVENUE OR ADJACENT FROM THE SALON IN A PARKING LOT.

Guests to watch competition:

There will be a seating area for guests to watch the contestants, there will not be any talking aloud during the competition.

Clothing Requirement

For men: Official SkillsUSA white dress shirt, black dress slacks, black socks and black leather work or dress shoes.

For women: Official white top, black dress slacks, black socks or black or skin-tone hose, and black leather, work or dress shoes.

For models: Businesslike, white, collarless blouse; black dress slacks or skirt; black or skin-tone hose and black shoes.

Eligibility: Open to active SkillsUSA members enrolled in programs with cosmetology/esthetics as the occupational objective.

Supplied by contestant:

a. Model: Models must be student members, but not necessarily from an esthetics program and may be either a high school or college/postsecondary student from any school in the state; must be dressed appropriately as described in the required clothing statement; must have hair pulled away from the face with a white or black headband (cloth or plastic); must have a clean, cosmetic-free face; and, must not wear earrings, facial piercings or necklaces. Models will not be required to take the Professional Development Test, the skill-related written test or submit a résumé.

- All competitors must create a one-page résumé and submit a hard copy to the technical committee chair on Friday morning.
- Student Contestants: **Each contestant is responsible to bring Product and Equipment that is listed from the NEW 2013-2014 Technical Standards Items C thru R for the contest.**
- Cell phones must be turned off during the contest.
- **“NEW”** Students will need to provide a current school Photo I.D. or Driver’s License.
All contestants will need to show that their proper I.D. matches the SkillsUSA Contestant Name Badge for competition.
- Setup can only consist of items needed for the specific contest application in progress. Time will be allowed between each contest segment to reset the table. All items should be brought to the contest site organized by task.
- Required implements and products must be accounted for and professionally organized. Proper control and usage of products and tools will be expected at all times.
- All products used in any portion of the skill contests must be considered safe for application to the skin.
- Conversation between contestant and model is limited. Any form of communication with observers, judges and other contestants is prohibited during the contest.
